- ! Open to BRAHA members and non members alike. All breeds of horse and pony are welcome. This Show follows USEF and AHA rules. Please review the rules for specifications of individual classes. This show is not rated.
- ! All junior exhibitors, whenever mounted, must wear an ASTM-approved helmet. Every rider is encouraged to wear protective headgear in every class.
- ! **The main horse show ring will be divided this year.** The upper 2/3's of the ring nearest the announcer's stand will be designated as **Ring 1**. **Ring 2** will be the lower 1/3 of the ring. Enter using the gates closes to the woods. Please be aware of gate access when parking around the ring. Both rings will run simultaneously.
- ! **Halter Championships** (7,11,15,16,20,24,25,30) do not require an entry fee. Placing 1st and 2nd in other classes result in entry in these classes.
- ! **Go As You Please Classes** - Enter the ring at a walk. When the judge calls "Go As You Please", you may canter/lope or trot/jog your horse. Whichever of these 2 gaits you select, you **MUST** use again when going the other direction of the ring.
- ! **Sport Horse:** Horses will be shown in hand at the walk and trot on the triangle. Brides are optional on two-year-olds, mandatory on horses three years old and older. A bridle shall be a dressage or hunter-type with snaffle bit with or without cheeks, keepers allowed, reins, and headstall with throatlatch. Noseband is optional. A split or single chain may be used with or instead of reins. Horses under the age of two must be shown in plain leather stable halters. Conservative attire is recommended for the handler. The handler may carry one whip. The sport horse class is scored 40% on conformation, 40% on movement, 10% on manners and 10% overall breed characteristics and suitability as a Sport Horse.
