NO POST ENTRIES

- ! All Horses, Mules and Mammoth Jacks, six months or older, must have proof of negative Coggins test within 12 months of the show date. Copy **must accompany entry form**. Attach a photo copy of Coggins test for each animal. Original Coggins papers must be brought on Show Day.
- ! **Show will be held Rain or Shine. All fees are non-refundable.**
- ! No entries accepted after deadline.
- ! **Must use Entry Form in catalog. Mail all entries to: Marie and Earle Nicholson, 3301 Urbana Pike, Ijamsville, MD 21754-9434. Make check payable to: Howard County Fair Association, Inc.**
- ! All Draft Horse and Mule exhibitors will receive two (2) passes for up to three (3) animals. Over three (3) animals may receive up to, but not more than, four (4) passes.
- ! Judges' decisions are final.

SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE OR SPLIT CLASSES AS NUMBER OF ENTRIES WARRANT.

Classes are listed in the tentative order they will be run--may be changed as needed.

DRESS CODE FOR DRAFT HALTER CLASSES: Dress slacks, shirt or blouse, tie and hat optional. No blue or faded jeans or T-shirts.

YOUTH 18 & OVER MAY WAIVE THEIR YOUTH STATUS, AND WILL BE CONSIDERED AS ADULT FOR ALL CLASSES, BUT CANNOT SHOW IN YOUTH CLASSES. This MUST be stated on the entry form.

YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP: Judged 70% showmanship, 30% condition of animal and grooming. Use of a trailer (whip) is optional. (All participants will receive cash awards from M.D.H.M.A.)

NOTE: Youth may not show stallions over one (1) year of age in any classes, including driving and under saddle. Youth age 8 to 19 years, as of date of the show. Draft Horses or Mule Youth may also drive any **team or multiple hitch classes**, **but must be accompanied by a responsible adult.**

UNDER SADDLE CLASSES: English or Western tack, **no driving bridles or bareback pads.** Judged as a pleasure riding class at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. To stand quietly and back easily. **NO STALLIONS. ALL MUST BE PURE DRAFT — NOT SPOTS.**

PREMIUMS for Classes 79 thru 81: Ribbons Only

- 79. **DRAFT HORSE UNDER SADDLE**- Adult rider 20 years or older.
- 80. **DRAFT MULE UNDER SADDLE**- Adult rider 20 years or older.
- 81. **DRAFT HORSE & MULE UNDER SADDLE** - Youth to ride, ages 8-19. All youth will receive cash awards from M.D.H.M.A.

LUNCH

HITCH CLASSES will be judged at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, suitability, condition and performance of team and driver. May be asked to back or perform individual test at judge's discretion. Youth classes judged on driver performance only.

DRESS CODE: Gentlemen--*Dress slacks, coat and tie, hat and proper shoes are mandatory. No denim jeans. Ladies-- Formal dress or long skirt and blouse. Dress pantsuits are permitted.*

82. **ANTIQUE FARM IMPLEMENT - HORSE OR MULE** PREMIUM: \$100.00

NOTE: No wagons. Implement must be in good repair. Judged on manners, suitability and general appearance. All exhibitors in this class will split the premium money equally, minimum of \$10 per exhibitor. Ribbons will be awarded in the Danish manner; judge may award two or more blue (or red) ribbons if more than one entry is worthy of that placing.

NOTE: For Classes 83 thru 89 and Classes 92 thru 97, driver must be 20 years of age or older, unless Youth status is waived.

- ! Pointed by: FOSH, MATWHA, PWHM, UMH NE Region.
- ! **NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED.**
- ! All TWH, Racking Horses, SSH and Mountain Horses will be inspected by the DQP.
- ! Other than those classes limited to the Lite Shod shoe, the maximum shoe allowed will be the 1" by ½" shoe.
- ! Trail Pleasure Class: maximum shoe size is Lite Shod 3/4" x 3/8".
- ! Adult Beginner 2-Gait is an Adult Only class (open to all breeds) for exhibitors who are in their first year in the show ring. Neat attire is requested. Formal English/Western attire or tack is not required. Horses will be judged on true road and trail qualities. Western riders may use two hands. Animation should not be a factor.
- ! In any Western class, the judge may call for a halt on the rail and/or to back clear of the lineup and do a 360 degree turn, in place.
- ! Tack changes must be reported 5 classes prior to the class, and will be allowed 5 minutes.
- ! There will be no plastic wrap or hoof bands allowed on the horses on the show grounds.
- ! Persons on HPA suspension cannot transport horses to this show and can participate only as a spectator.
