- ! **NOTE: Due to the 60th Anniversary Fair Celebration on Friday Evening, August 5th, no Dairy Cattle Exhibits (neither cattle nor tack) will be accepted on the fairgrounds between 4:30 and 10:30 p.m. on that day.**
- ! **Jersey** Dairy Cattle must be on the fairgrounds by **12 Noon** on opening Saturday. This group must stay until **9:00 p.m. Monday** and must be out by **9:00 a.m. on Tuesday**. **Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Holstein** and **Milking Shorthorns** may not arrive at the Fairgrounds until **Midnight Tuesday** and must be checked in by **1:00 p.m. Wednesday**. This group may leave on **Saturday** after **9:00 p.m.**
- ! **Guaranteed premium of \$10.00/animal for all classes.**

4. Summer Yearling, born, June 1 thru August 31
5. Junior Yearling Heifer, born March 1 thru May 31
6. Senior Yearling Heifer, born December 1, thru February 28
7. Senior Yearling Heifer, born September 1 thru November 30
8. Junior Champion Female, under 2 years
9. Junior Best 3 Females - Animals must have been shown in Classes 1-7. All bred and owned by exhibitor. Limited to one entry per exhibitor.
10. Junior 2 year old, born March 1 thru August 31
11. Senior 2 year old, born September 1 thru February 28
12. Junior 3 year old, born March 1 thru August 31
13. Cows, 3 years old, born September 1 thru February 28
14. Cows, 4 years old, born September 1 thru August 31
15. Cows, 5 years old, born September 1 thru August 31
16. Cows, 6 years and over, born before September 1
17. Dry cow, 3 years and older, must have freshened at least once
18. Senior Champion Female
19. Grand Champion Female
20. Cow in milk, to be judged on udder alone
21. Produce of Dam--Group to consist of 2 animals, any age, either sex, produce of one cow. The dam must be named. Each exhibitor limited to one entry from the same dam.
22. Dam Daughter Class--2 animals, any age, need not both be owned by one exhibitor
23. Senior Best 3 Females, two years old and older, all bred and owned by the exhibitor. Each exhibitor limited to one entry.
24. Breeders Herd of 5 Females--Consists of 2 females under 2 years, 2 females over 2 years of age, and 1 female any age. All to be owned by one exhibitor. Four of these must be bred by exhibitor.
